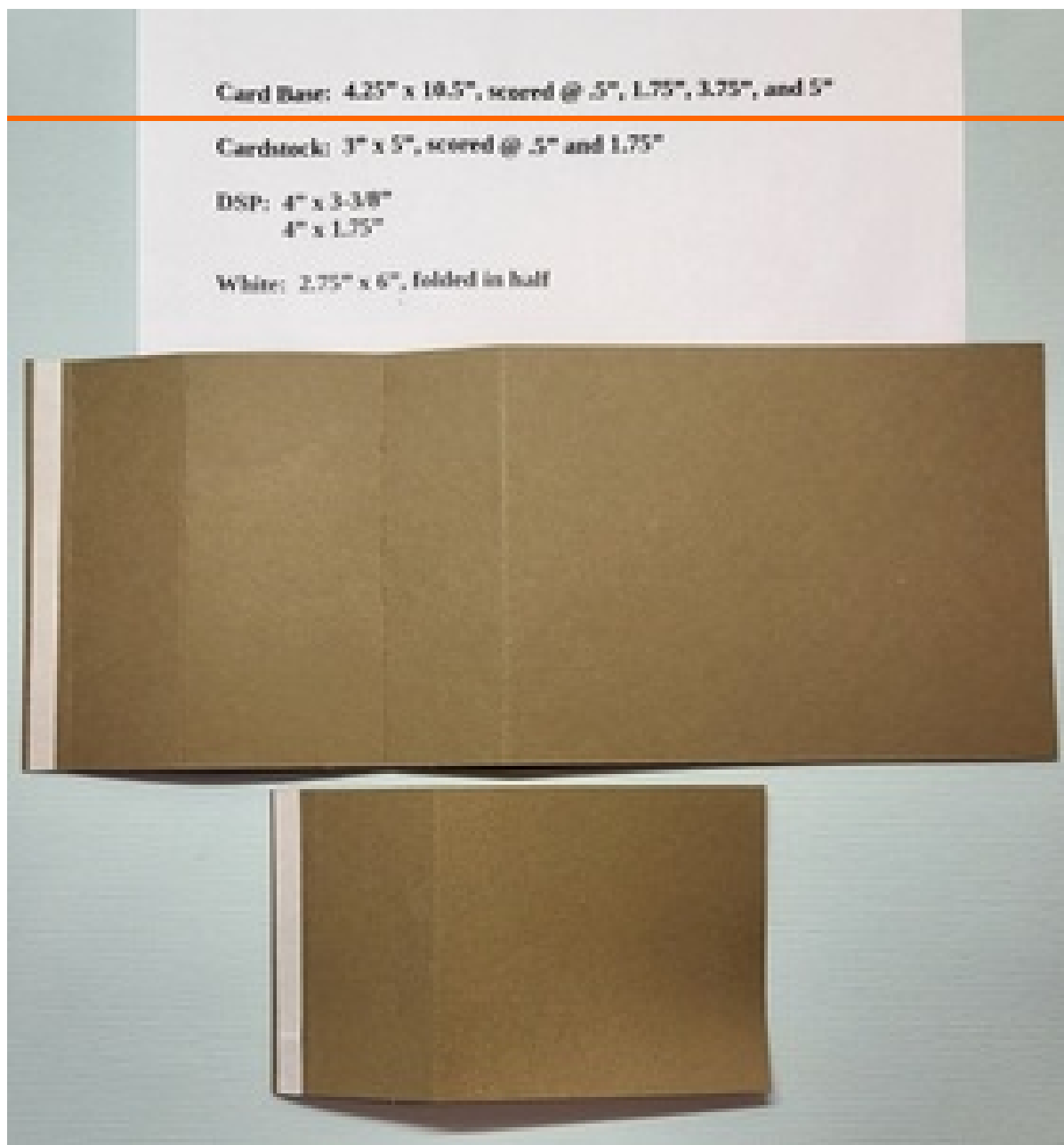




## PROJECT RECIPE

### Standing Pop-Up Card

Card Base: 4.25" x 10.5", scored @ .5", 1.75", 3.75", and 5"

Cardstock: 3" x 5", scored @ .5" and 1.75"

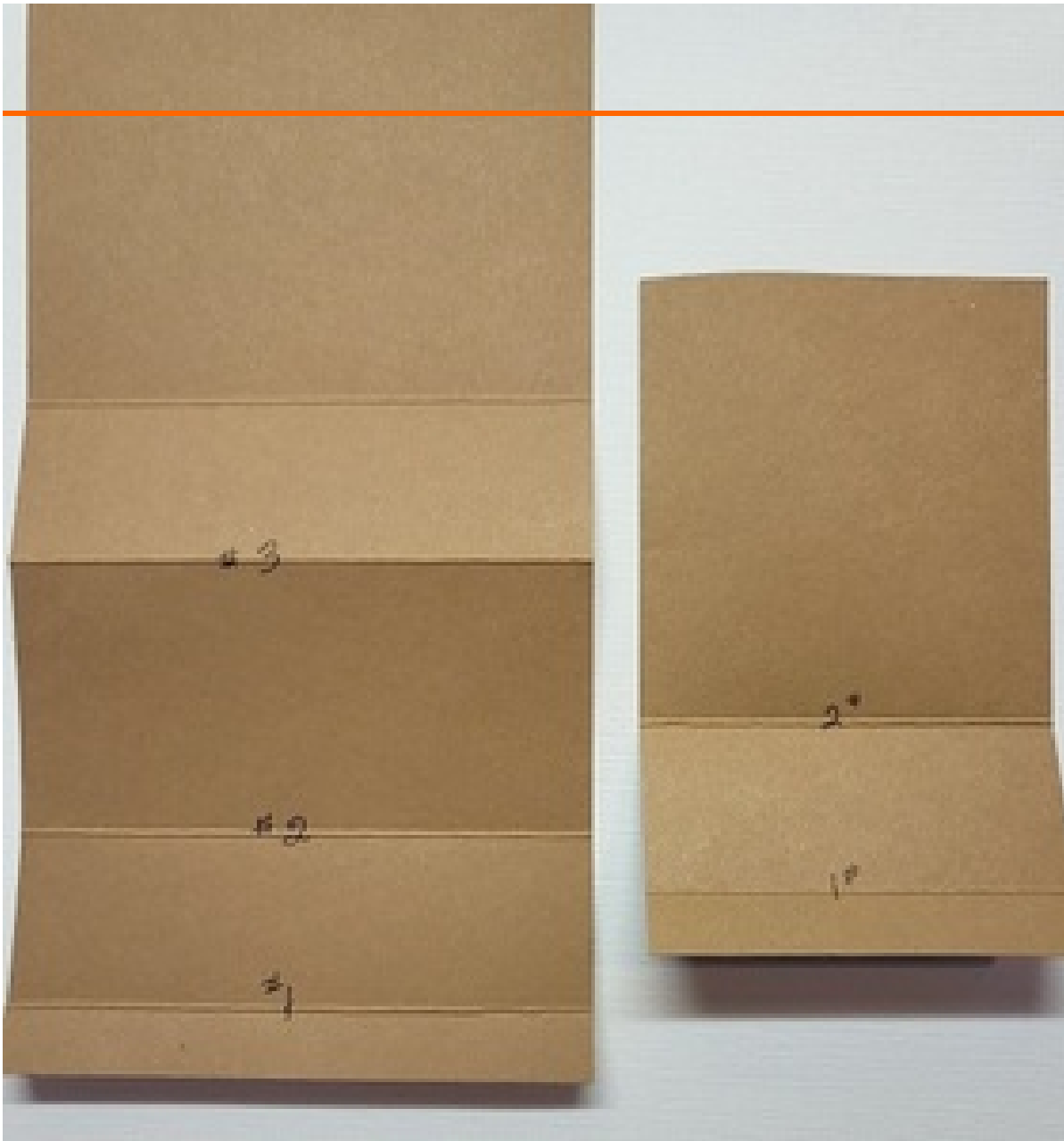
DSP: 4" x 3-3/8"

4" x 1.75"

White: 2.75" x 6", folded in half

Score the 4.25" x 10.5" card base @ 1/2", 1-3/4", 3-3/4", and 5"

Score the 3" x 5" piece @ 1/2" & 1-3/4"



Fold up from the bottom score lines, on score line #3, & add adhesive on the 1/2" area, and tuck under to adhere to the rest of the card base. If you add the dsp to the top area first, then your tucked 1/2" fold will be just below the dsp.



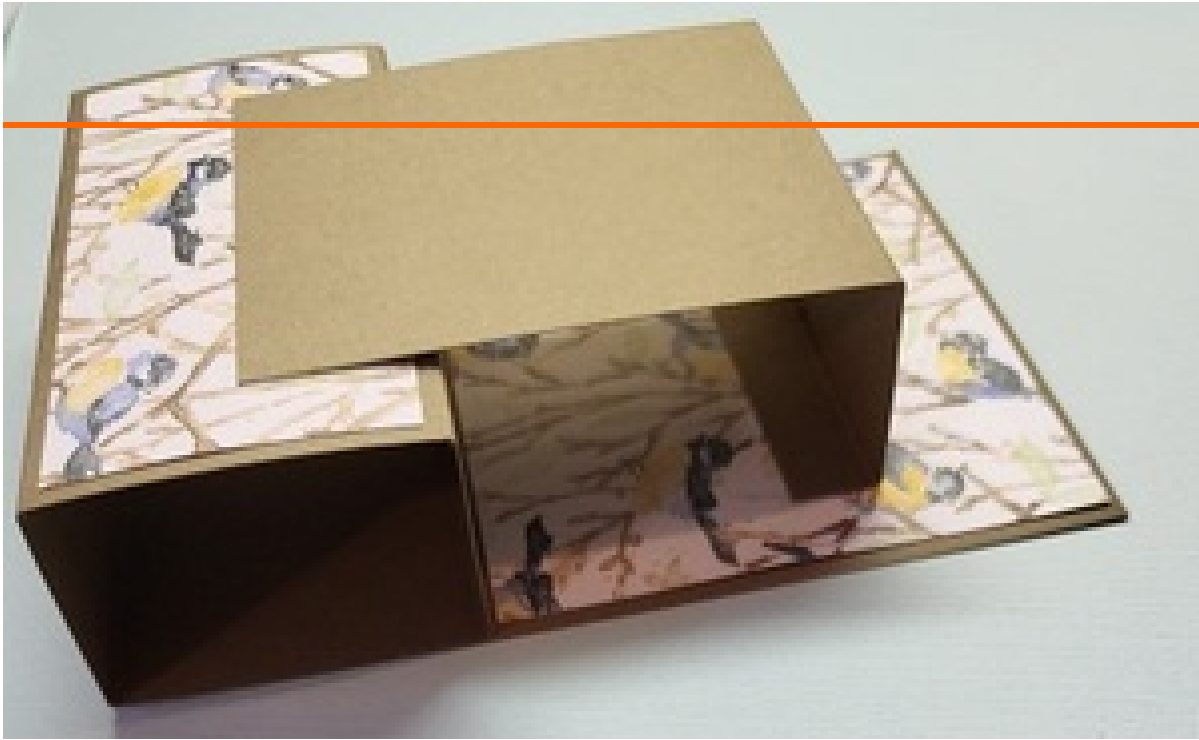
Add adhesive or tear & tape to the 1/2" area of the 3" x 5" piece. Fold down on the 1-3/4" score line. Center this fold on the top of the card, pressing down firmly where the adhesive is on the 1/2" score line.



Add adhesive or tear & tape as shown, fold card flat and lay this fold down on the bottom strip of dsp.



Fold flat like this.



Now it should look like this.



Fold the 2-3/4" x 6" mini card base in half. Stamp as desired, and attach to your card. Place dimensionals as shown to add a die cut or punched piece, to keep your card flap closed.
